

-MV102 ESCONDIDO Y FAGNANO LAKE-

Heading north with the majestic view of Mount Olivia and the Cinco Hermanos we go on an excursion to Escondido and Fagnano Lake.



Once on the national route number three the landscape changes dramatically, the valley of Carbajal will be the first panoramic point. An imposing valley of glacial origin with millenary peat bogs.



short distance away will be the new point of interest, a walk lasting an hour and a half to a panoramic point to appreciate the valley of Tierra Mayor with the imposing Mount Alvear.

Along the way you can learn about the famous peat bogs, the predominant ecosystem in this area. It is the ideal place to enjoy a snack (Mate, Coffee, Tea or Hot Chocolate) commenting stories and activities that take place in the area.

The winter centers, with cross-country skiing, ski mountaineering, snowmobiling, dog sledding, all in winter season activity and in summer activities such as mountaineering, hiking, etc.

In the next kilometers the High deciduous forests, Low deciduous forests, Evergreen forests show us the way, waterfalls

and millenary peat bogs until arriving to the Garibaldi Pass, located at 430 meters above sea level. It is the panoramic point. It unveils the majesty of Escondido Lake and Fagnano Lake.



If time permits, we will take a walk to get into the mysteries of the flora and fauna of Tierra del Fuego.

The Escondido Lake is the ideal place to taste our exquisite lunch at the edge of the lake.



Later we will visit the shores of Lake Fagnano and then return to the city of Ushuaia. Total kilometers to cover: 120.
