

-MV103 ESCONDIDO LAKE, FAGNANO LAKE AND TOLHUIN -

Heading north with the majestic view of Mount Olivia and the Cinco Hermanos we go on an excursion to Escondido, Fagnano until we reach Tolhuin.



Once on the national route number three the landscape changes dramatically, the valley of Carbajal will be the first panoramic point. An imposing valley of glacial origin with millenary peat bogs.

A short distance away will be the new point of interest, a walk of an hour and a half to a panoramic point to appreciate the valley of Tierra Mayor with the imposing Mount Alvear.



In the course you can learn about the famous peat bogs, the predominant ecosystem in this area. The winter centers, with cross-country skiing, ski mountaineering, snowmobiling, dog sledding, all in winter season activity and in summer activities such as mountaineering, hiking, etc.

In the next kilometers the High deciduous forests, Low deciduous forests, Evergreen forests show us the way, waterfalls and millenary peat bogs until arriving at the Garibaldi Pass, located 430 meters above sea level, is the panoramic point. We unveil the majesty of Escondido and Fagnano Lakes.



Weather permitting, we will take a hike to delve into the mysteries of the flora and fauna of Tierra del Fuego.



Later we will visit the Fagnano Lake up to its headwaters, continuing to the city of Tolhuin.

We will see the third city of Tierra del Fuego with its special physiognomy, we will visit the famous Union Bakery, a must-see attraction.

We will return to the city of Ushuaia. Total, kilometers to cover: 120.
